



What to do after you have been accepted to begin your Career as a Barber at Mr. BARBER Training Centre

You have 7 days to either arrange payment or apply to studylink from acceptance

COURSE: NZ Certificate in Commercial Barbering L4

Cost: \$6907.00 Monday to Friday 9.30-4pm

To pay for your course you can either pay yourself or you can apply for a student loan from studylink at www.studylink.govt.nz for an

- Allowance
- Student loan (to pay for your fees)
- Course Related costs (up to \$1000.00 to purchase equipment

You will also need to go to the post office or post shop and sign up for a **Realme account**.

Make sure you take your evidence

- Passport or Birth Certificate or Citizen documents all verified by a JP
- Bank statement
- IRD card or letter from the IRD

Once Studylink has processed your application they will send you a contract that you will need to sign and return to them by uploading it to connect <https://www.connect.co.nz/>
If you haven't had a student loan before they will post it to you. If you have had a student loan before you can do it all online.

When Studylink accepts your application, they will then pay the fees into an account with Public Trust. Public Trust will then pay us.

Your allowance will be paid into the bank account you have nominated.

You can then go back into your Studylink account and apply for course related costs for your equipment. They will pay that amount into your bank account. You need to do this as soon as you are accepted as it can take 3 weeks before study link finalises the application.

Once you have started we will give you a student card with a Transport sticker on it to enable you to apply for discounted bus or train fares.
